

## **DXLog - EU-HF Championship History file (Prefill database)**

Updated: July 18, 2025

ZIP file contains 2 files:

- "EUHFC\_db.txt" (callsigns and last two digits of the year of operator's first ever official amateur radio license)
- "README.pdf" file (this help file)

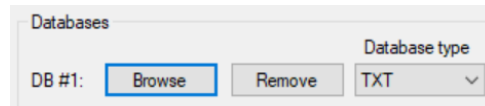
The "EUHFC\_db.txt" database drives the exchange guessing feature of DXLog Logging Software.

When a callsign is typed into the Entry window and the Space bar is pressed, the Call History database is searched. If the callsign is found, the associated Call History data (license year) is displayed / prefilled.

### **How to load the file into DXLog:**

- save the call history file " EUHFC\_db.txt " to a known place on your computer, usually in your DXLog files in folder **.../Database**
- go to menu **Options / Data files / Prefill database settings**
- set DB #1 (or DB #2, your choice...)

- select: "Database type" **TXT**



- navigate to where the file is located and select "EUHFC\_db.txt "
- define database fields as follows (default settings)



- hit OK and you're ready to go
